Incident Management Training

What is it?

This course is designed for groups that operate in outdoor or wilderness environments. Training ensures that the group's response to an incident is effective and in line with best practice. Training is centred on the group's policies and systems both for immediate management on the ground and liaison with next of kin, media and other interested parties.

How long does it last?

Between one and two days. Typically training runs from 9am to 5.30pm each day.

What does it cover?

- Incident response plan
- Threat and risk assessment
- Principles of incident management
- First Aid
- Communication
- Logistics
- Interface with ISOS insurance (if applicable)
- Working with locals and emergency services
- External medical advice
- Evacuations
- Scenario testing

Often delivered with:

- Crisis Team Training
- First Aid
